Topic Based Action Groups

Community Energy Action Group - encourages the development of community renewable energy projects.

Culture Shift - uses creativity to connect with people and encourage people towards sustainability.

Edible Stroud - plants fruit bushes and trees and other edible plants in public spaces around the town, for all to enjoy.

Low Carbon Mapping Group - is developing a website to map initiatives that contribute to achieving carbon neutrality.

Repair Café - fixes electrical and other items in return for a donation.

Stroud Community TV - makes, watches and shares videos that celebrate life in the Five Valleys.

Stroud District Action on Plastic – helps eliminate unnecessary single use plastic across the District.

Textiles Group - mends clothes, swaps fabric, knits and crochets, and learns new skills.

Transport Group - works to improve bus provision and other shared transport.

Local Climate Action Groups

Transition Stroud recognises that working with climate action groups in local communities is key to moving forward with a wide range of low

carbon initiatives, covering energy, transport, food, waste, environmental adaptation and resilience building.

Transition Stroud encourages and enables groups to form in local communities. We organise 'start-up' workshops in liaison with local stakeholders.

We convene a Local Groups Forum to enable the sharing of information, experience and ideas, and take initiatives to support an effective network of groups.

Workshop and Events

Transition Stroud organises workshops on a range of topics – from climate change to resilience building and gaining new skills. We also organise other types of events, including public meetings and film evenings.

We also support a range of occasional events, including Eco Homes Weekend, Open Edible Gardens and Potato Day.
